
Photography Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that photography and videography within Cumbre Sports Facility are conducted in a manner that respects the privacy, safety, and wellbeing of all patrons, particularly children and young people, while also allowing for the positive promotion of our activities and community spirit.

2. Scope

This policy applies to:

- All visitors, participants, staff, volunteers, contractors, and event organisers within the Cumbre Sports Facility premises.
- All areas of the facility, including courts, café, bar, function spaces, and spectator areas.
- All types of photography and videography, including still images, video recordings, and live streaming.

3. General Principles

Cumbre Sports Facility supports responsible photography and encourages capturing the positive moments of sport and community. However, the facility has an obligation to:

- Protect the privacy and safety of participants, particularly minors.
- Prevent misuse of images.
- Maintain a comfortable and respectful environment for all patrons.

4. Personal Photography and Videography

- Spectators and participants are permitted to take photos or short videos **for personal use only**, provided that:
 - The images focus on friends, family, or team members.
 - No images are taken in changing rooms, bathrooms, or staff-only areas.
 - The photography does not disrupt play, interfere with staff operations, or make others uncomfortable.
- If any person objects to being photographed, their wishes must be respected immediately.

5. Commercial or Organised Photography

- Any photography or videography for **commercial, promotional, or professional purposes** requires **prior written approval** from Cumbre Sports Facility management.
 - This includes:
 - Media coverage
 - Marketing material
 - Team photos taken by professional photographers
 - Filming for sponsorship, advertising, or social media campaigns
 - Approved photographers must:
 - Sign in at reception and wear identification when on site.
 - Comply with all instructions from facility staff.

6. Social Media and Online Sharing

- Photos or videos shared online (including social media) must:
 - Portray subjects in a respectful and positive manner.
 - Not identify minors by full name without written consent from a parent or guardian.
 - Not be altered or used in a misleading or inappropriate context.
 - The facility reserves the right to request removal of any image or video that breaches this policy or is deemed inappropriate.

7. Facility Photography and Promotion

- Cumbre Sports Facility may take photos or videos during programs, competitions, or events for promotional purposes.
- Signage will be displayed when photography or filming is taking place.
- Patrons who do not wish to be photographed should inform staff or event organisers in advance.

8. Reporting Concerns

9. Breaches of Policy

Anyone found to be breaching this policy may be:

- Asked to stop taking photos or video.
 - Requested to delete images or recordings.
 - Asked to leave the premises.
 - Reported to relevant authorities if the behaviour raises safeguarding or legal concerns.
